

PRIVACY POLICY

In MPASS Ltd we know how important it is to protect your personal data. Our Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand what information is obtained from you and how we collect, use, process and store the information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when visiting our Web Site. This Privacy Policy applies regardless of whether you use a computer, mobile phone, tablet, TV or home appliance or other smart device to access our Services.

For purposes of this Agreement, "Web Site" or "Site" refers to the MPASS Ltd website, which can be accessed at www.airmessenger.ai. The terms "we", "us" and "our" refer to MPASS Ltd. "You" refers to you as a visitor of our Site.

By accessing our Site, you accept our Privacy Policy and Terms of Use.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We only collect information you provide us directly. We don't rely on information we obtain from third party sources.

We collect anonymous information that cannot be used to personally identify you, such as anonymous usage of data, general demographic information we may collect, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform types, number of clicks, etc.

We track anonymous information provided to us by your browser, such as the type of browser you use, the device from which you are connected to our Site, the time and date of access and other information that does not personally identify you.

In our REQUEST A DEMO form you enter your first name, last name, email address and optionally phone number, company name, job title. We collect all the provided data in the REQUEST A DEMO form, and store them anonymously using randomization techniques. An indication in the Site is included, that by requesting a demo, you confirm that you have read & agreed Privacy Terms. Only authorized person is able to obtain your actual provided contact details in order to communicate with you via email. In any subsequent communication, an opt-out option will be included in any email you will receive.

We may also ask for your separate consent to the collection of information or to notify you separately about how we collect your personal information in a manner not described in this Privacy Policy as required for certain additional services.

HOW WE USE INFORMATION

We do not sell, trade, rent or otherwise share for marketing purposes your information with third parties. In general, we use Non-Personal Information to improve our Site and your experience. We also aggregate Non-Personal Information to track trends and analyze use patterns on the Site.

We use the information we collect the contact information you provide us to send custom content, promotions, news and information about MPASS services, products and projects, after giving your individual consent where necessary.

HOW WE RETAIN INFORMATION

We will not retain your provided information for a longer period of time than is required for the purpose for which it was collected. This means that these data will be destroyed or deleted by our systems when they will no longer be necessary.

We take reasonable steps to ensure that we process and maintain your information based on the following reasoning:

1. at least for the length of time for which the information is provided to provide a service, such as emails or newsletters
2. as required by law, a contract or our legal obligations; or
3. only where necessary for the purpose for which they were collected, processed or for a longer period, if required under any contract, by the applicable legislation or for statistical purposes, provided that they are subject to appropriate protection measures.

YOUR CONTROL ON INFORMATION

To request rectification of inaccurate data, erasure of data, restriction of processing on your provided data, or a data portability request, please send an email, using the one that you have registered, to gdpr@mpass.gr, describing the issue. We will process your request at a highest priority. We will send a notification obligation to your email regarding rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing.

INFORMATION SECURITY

We maintain appropriate administrative, technical and physical protection measures designed to protect the information you provide through the Site against accidental, unlawful or unauthorized destruction, interference, loss, tampering, access, disclosure or use.

Specifically:

- We control the collected anonymous data, storage and processing practices, including physical security measures, to protect against unauthorized access to systems. The data collected are maintained on secured networks and systems, where only authorized personnel has access rights.
- We implement security measures designed to protect all Information from unauthorized access. We further protect all Information collected from potential security breaches by implementing certain technological security measures including encryption, firewalls and secure socket layer technology.

Your use of our Site will result in the transfer, storage and processing of your provided information in countries in the European Economic Area.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

We do not sell, trade, rent or otherwise share your information with other companies, organizations, and individuals outside MPASS Ltd.

LINKS TO OTHER SITES

In our Site, we may provide links to other sites or applications. However, we are not responsible for the privacy practices employed by those websites, or the Information/content they contain.

This Privacy Policy applies solely to Information collected by us, through the Site. Therefore, this Privacy Policy does not apply to your use of a third-party website accessed by selecting a link on our Site.

CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY

The MPASS Ltd reserves the right to change this Policy and our Terms of Service at any time. We will notify you by placing a prominent notice on our Site. Significant changes will go into effect immediately.

APPLICABLE LAW AND OTHER TERMS

The above terms and conditions, as in force from time to time, are governed by Greek and European law and any disputes arising therefrom shall come under the jurisdiction of the Courts of Athens.
